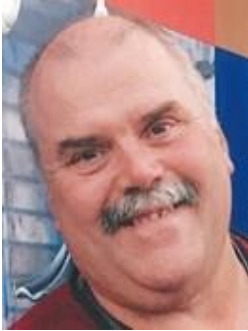


Mancuso, Joseph Jr.
