

Singer, Priscilla Lynn (Lohse) November 22, 1949 - May 11, 2015

Priscilla Lynn (Lohse) Singer, of Souderton, PA, passed away Monday, May 11, 2015, at her home. She was 65. She was the wife of Richard A. Singer. The couple would have celebrated their 45th Wedding Anniversary on May 30, 2015.

Born in Erie, PA, she was the daughter of the late Wilfird J. 'Biff' and Eleanor M. 'Nornie' (Konigsbauer) Lohse. She was a 1967 graduate of Lansdale Catholic High School, Lansdale, PA.
