

Joseph M. Molnar, Jr.

Joseph M. Molnar, Jr., 56, died June 3, 2002, at his home, from complications related to heart disease. He was the husband of Diane (Kukoda) Molnar and they had observed their 29th wedding anniversary in March. Formerly of Lansdale, he lived in Hatfield since 1972.

Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of Rita E (Schillow) Molnar of Lansdale and the late Joseph M. Molnar, Sr. He graduated from Lansdale Catholic High School, Class of 1963 and continued his education by taking courses at LaSalle University and Montgomery County Community College. A veteran of the U.S. Army, he served during the Vietnam era.

Mr. Molnar had a career in inside sales. He currently was employed by Arobone and Co. Inc. in Hatfield. Previously he worked at the R. D. Bitzer Co. in Elkins Park and Honeywell, Inc. in Fort Washington.

He was president of the Hatfield Planning Commission and had served on the sewer boards of Hatfield Township and Hatfield Borough.

He was a member of St. Maria Goretti Church in Hatfield.

He was a member and past treasurer of the American Legion Post No. 933 in Hatfield and belonged to Lansdale V.F.W. Post No. 32.

In addition to his wife and mother, he is survived by a son, Joseph M. Molnar, of Maple Shade, NJ; a daughter, Mary G. Molnar of Kulpsville; a brother, William J Molnar and his wife, Debbi of Havertown; and a sister, Marjorie J. McCormick and her husband, Tim, of Long Island, NY.
