North Wales youth dies from gunshot wound

Paul Chirico, 18, of 203 N. Main St., North Wales died Thursday evening in North Penn Hospital, Lansdale, after being admitted Wednesday night.

According to North Wales police, Chirico shot himself in the head with a 22 rifle about 9:15 p.m. Wednesday. He was taken to the hospital by the Volunteer Medical Service Corps.
