

Roger W. Kaelin, 76, of Daytona Beach Shores, FL passed away Sunday, July 3, 2022, at his residence. He was born October 4, 1945, in Lansdale, PA, a son of Joseph J. Kaelin and Marian (McGowan) Kaelin Kohn. He married Christine (Davies) Kaelin of Saegertown on April 8, 1967.
