Rosemary Scully Mascaro, 77, of Bradenton, FL, died peacefully at home surrounded by her loving family. She was a loving mother, sister, aunt, grandmother, and most recently, great-grandmother.

She was born in Clifton Heights, PA and shortly after moved to Lansdale, PA, where she resided for 18 years. While living in Lansdale, Rosemary attended St. Stanislaus School and graduated from Lansdale Catholic High School in 1962.
