Victor R. Lelii, 88, of Harleysville, Pennsylvania, passed peacefully on November 10, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. He was born June 21, 1937, in Ambler, PA, to Victor and Nora (Gagliani) Lelii.

Vic attended Saint Joseph's Elementary School, graduated from Lansdale Catholic High School, and earned a degree from Penn State University.

He loved his family and was a devoted husband of 65 years to his wife, Linda. He was a proud father of 5, poppop of 16, and doting great-grandfather of 6. He enjoyed working in his yard and spending time in his meticulous, well-organized garage. If you were looking for Vic on a Sunday morning or Tuesday evening, you could find him on the golf course.

Vic worked as a production manager at Standard Press Steel in Jenkintown for 44 years. In retirement, he especially enjoyed his work of 9 years at Saint Maria Goretti Church. In addition, he was a Eucharistic Minister for 23 years and a member of the adult server funeral team. He had many accomplishments, including being the baby whisperer (he never met a baby that didn't love him), shooting his age in golf numerous times, hole-in-one at Pine Crest Golf Course at age 77, and a gold medal winner at the Montgomery County Senior Games for Cornhole as he represented Arbour Square.
